

SM- What is the inspiration behind what you do?




We have the new album next then after that's released, we have solo albums coming from us both. Also, we are in the works of putting together a comic book titled (Tha Po Kids)

Rockingham, NC's own unsigned artist, Mark Hyde Jr A.K.A. Yung Rydah was born on 4/22/1994 & has been making music since the age of thirteen. Rydah started rapping with fellow friend, Rashaad Leak, and his cousins PJ (Glo) & Shaun (Retro). While rapping together, Rydah grew his confidence and saw early he was meant for Hip Hop and destined for it. With the likes of DMX delivery and style, Yung Rydah was inspired by the rapper's Ruff Ryders presence. Music is everything to the Rockingham rapper, so much so, he refers to it as his calling. Writing and recording is where Rydah thrives as he envisions bringing his raps to Life. Yung Rydah adopted his own style being born in Rockingham and raised in Charlotte, NC. Some of that style adapted, is credited to his short residency in Texas. In Wichita Falls, TX is where Rydah started to gain his real fanbase. Starting from dropping songs via SoundCloud in 2012-2013, he began to gain a buzz with the song "House Party". He was only a featured artist on the song, but his verse made people want to tune in more with his music. He later dropped more music & from there he kept going. His music catalog is big, with him releasing seven mixtapes, 2 EP's, a select few singles, & his debut album "SOMEWHAT Famous". His biggest song is the smash hit single "Or Whatever" which he released at the beginning of 2020. It grew to be a major success at the start of the COVID-19 outbreak. We Rollin' Records is an independent record label founded in the late 1990s by Sharon Ford. The label was incorporated in the state of Maryland in 2013. Sharon is a native of the Nation's Capital. Her initial goal was to pursue a career in cosmetology. After becoming a licensed cosmetologist in Washington, D.C., she received advance training at the Vidal Sassoon School of Hair Design in London, England. Her cosmetology career came to an abrupt halt due to a severe allergic reaction to cosmetic chemicals. Sharon chose acting, modeling, then rapping which prompted her to attend the Maryland Academy of Dramatic Arts and later studied at the Collier Casting Acting Center in New York. She got her first acting job as an extra in numerous scenes on the 1989 television series A Man Called Hawk starring, Avery Brooks, who's best known for the 1990s T.V. series Star Trek Deep Space Nine. She appeared as an extra in Spike Lee's Malcolm X and the MTV Direct Effect Show. Sharon also did promo modeling work for E&J Brandy (Liquors). Sharon later worked as a music critic for a D.C. based hip-hop magazine called, Straight From the Street in the 1990s where she attended many albums release parties and events for recording stars. Sharon also recorded a few rap songs produced by Vaughan Mason who's from the 80's funk group, Vaughan Mason & Crew with popular hits such as: Bounce Rock Skate Roll. In the 1990s, she traveled to Lorain, Ohio to rap on a track co-written by R&B artist, David Tolliver from the duo Men At Large. Sharon's first stage performance was at the 2002 Tampax Total You Tour featuring guest speaker Queen Latifah. Sharon performed at Howard University's 2003 Homecoming Concert hosted by comedian Cory "Zoo" Miller, featuring comedian Lavell Crawford, both from BET Comic View. After researching the possibility of running her own record label, Sharon began to focus on building We Rollin' Records. In 2004, while working at a Maryland manufacturing company, she discovered Terry Rice, Sr. also known as Dzol. In 2013, Sharon arranged for celebrity music producer, Jaywon to produce a demo written by Dzol called "Let Dem Haters C Us." Jaywon arranged for rapper Jeezy to be featured on the demo. After the demo was completed, she arranged for Dzol to record his 12- track debut CD produced by Don Vito, who's an Atlanta based multi- platinum music producer. Vito is credited with hits for recording artists such as: Nelly, Ciara, and many others. He also produced the 2010 theme track for the Soul Train Awards red carpet event. Vito was the co-star of the 2013 reality show, The Kandi Factory. In December 2015, Dzol's debut single produced by Vito entitled, "Turnt Up" was released. The track is a vibrant, high-energy song. "Turnt Up" can also be found on DJ Ron G's March 2016 mixtape entitled "I Got It on Lock" featuring artists: Swizz Beatz; DMX, Iggy Azelea; Drake; LL Kool J and many others. Other tracks Vito produced for Dzol includes: "Own That" and "I Rocks," both isplay that raw club vibe. All Dzol's singles can be found on the digital music outlets including Spotify. The completed 12-track CD produced by Vito is orthcoming with a track entitled, Money Callin' featuring rap artist, Cap 1 and Sharon is also featured on the track. Another heart-pumping party track entitled, "I'm Baltimore" is a song that pays homage to the pro-football team as well as Dzol's roots in Baltimore. February 13, 2016, Sharon arranged for Dzol's first debut concert performance

at the Migos DAB Tour in Rochester, New York. In August 2016, she arranged for Dzol to become the opening act for the Ja Rule/Ashanti concert at the ElectricFactory venue in Philadelphia. In 2017, Dzol and We Rollin' Records parted ways amicably, so Sharon found another Washington, D.C. artist, Moe Gatz. Vito produced two tracks for Moe entitled, Pockets on E and Okay. Pockets on E is a track Moe wrote about people not living up to their full potential for success. Okay is a track about the people who have supported Moe. Moe writes his own lyrics, and he's inspired by life's challenges. In 2018, his track Ok reached number 1 on the DJ Digital Charts and in 2019, Pockets On E reached number 1. This led to Moe's singles being selected for airplay by 60 mainstream radio stations in the U.S. and a few stations outside the country in November 2019. This includes Sharon's hometown Washington, DC radio station93.9 WKYS and other popular radio stations with celebrity DJs such as Big Tigger from V-103 (WVEE-FM radio) in Atlanta, Georgia. Moe's tracks can also be found on all the digital outlets worldwide, including Spotify. During the pandemic of 2020, the music and entertainment world came to an abrupt halt. During that time Moe decided to leave music. In 2022, Dzol returned to We Rollin' Records and by that time, Sharon had developed a business relationship with CSP Music Group founded by Christopher Starr based in Atlanta, who's credited for working with Beyoncé, Ed Sheeran, and a host of othersIn 2023, CSP Music Group's Sam Peezy, produced a track for Dzol called, "Go Out and Get It." This is a track about achieving your goals despite obstacles. Peezy is a Grammy nominated & amp; Billboard charting producer who has worked with Emcee N.I.C.E.'s number one Billboard gospel track "Glory to God" the 69 Boys; Raheem Da Dream and many others. "Go Out and Get It" was released on all digital outlets in November 2023 and reached number five on the DJ Digital Chart. This track has been fluctuating high on the DJ Digital Chart above and below artists like Cardi B; Usher; Drake, and Chris Brown since August 2024. Sharon's forthcoming plans include more concert performances for Dzol. He has a ton of completed tracks

that are scheduled for release. Sharon also has a few more new potential artists that she plans to work with.

SM- What message are you hoping to get across to the people by doing what you do?

I want readers to know that We Rollin' Records will be more than just an entity that puts out great music. Our role will not be limited to just entertaining the fans. It's important for me to give back to society, especially when we are blessed to do so. Entertainers who serve the public have an obligation to inspire young people. I'm not perfect, but I'll do my best to fulfil my obligation as a positive role model with the moral integrity that's expected of me.

SM- Tell us about what you're promoting and the details around it?

I'm currently promoting my Hip-Hop artist Dzol and his latest single "Go Out and Get It" which was produced by CSP Music Group's Sam Peezy, a Grammy nominated & Billboard Charting Producer who's worked with Emcee N.I.C.E.'s number one Billboard gospel track "Glory to God" the 69 Boys; and many others. Dzol's track "Go Out and Get It" has been fluctuating high on the DJ Digital Chart above and below artists like Cardi B, Usher, Drake, and Chris Brown since August 2024.

SM- What's unique about this that separates it from the rest?

She was highly respected in the business and that's why respect is high on my list.

There are plenty of supportive individuals and I couldn't have done it without them. One being Atlanta-based, Grammy nominated music producers Don Vito and Sam Peezy. My current business relationship is with Christopher Starr, Founder & CEO of CSP Music Group, who's worked with accomplished artists such as: Beyoncé, Ed Sheeran, Usher, and many others. Working with an established company like CSP who's known for marketing and promoting current recording stars make me feel as though I've "arrived." I realize that I'm on the same professional level as other independent record labels. I also feel a sense of accomplishment knowing I'm on the right path to success.
